

CARING FOR DUNNARTS

- **Water**
 - Please make sure that the water bowl has plenty of clean water
- **Food**
 - Dunnarts need to be fed daily. You have been provided with 2 eggs and 2 bags of dog meat. Each egg and bag should last one week. Place the second week of dog food in the freezer so it doesn't go off
 - Cut the egg into small pieces and feed with a teaspoon of dog meat. Dust the bowl with the supplement provided
 - They have a bowl of cat biscuits; this is their emergency food if they weren't fed enough
 - 2-3 mealworms can be fed to the dunnarts every other day
- **Cleaning**
 - Remove and replace food daily
- **Heating**
 - Ensure the heat light is kept on at all times
 - **BE CAREFUL** – The cage around the heat lamp will get hot
- Ensure students don't open the enclosure unsupervised, and that the lid is secure.
- Dunnarts are most active at dawn and dusk.
- Dunnarts must be checked every day over the weekend.
- If they are taken home over the weekend, make sure they are kept away from cats and dogs to avoid stress.
